## Reimbursement process

- ▶ RT workflow with guided process and more details
- ▶ Long-term: possibly Software Freedom Conservancy's reimbursement tool
- ▶ Paid help to streamline reimbursements



## Improving accounting process

- ▶ Get away from single point of failure
- ▶ Document everything
- ▶ More rigorous processes
- ▶ Proper expense policy
- ▶ Financial review or audit
